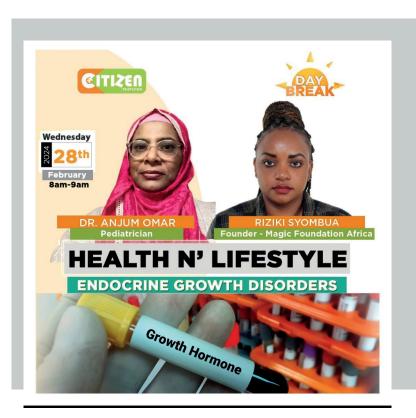

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GIVING BACK TO **SOCIETY**



We were fortunate to get donation inform of stadiometers which is a device used to capture heights in children. We have 47 counties in Kenya, we were able to distribute 13 of them, 10 to different county refferal hospitals with the help of Dr. Phoebe Wamalwa who is the current president of PESK and 3 went to community hospitals. This device will help doctors to capture and monitor children who are not thriving and might require early intervention and treatment. We are very honoured and grateful to our partners for their generous contribution

PART OF OUR ADVOCACY IS TO SPEAK ON BEHALF OF OUR PATIENTS ON PRESSING ISSUES THAT NEEDS TO BE ADDRESSED URGENTLY AS:

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ACQUISITION OF MEDICINES

There have been shortages of drugs and accessing them has not been easy, essential treatments are out of reach for many patients forcing them to withdraw from their ongoing treatment which has led to an increase of health complications in children and poor growth and development



HIGH COST OF TREATMENT & DRUGS

Tests, consultations and medications especially Human Growth Hormone (HGH) are very expensive, a pen of 12mg/1 ml, is currently at 30, 000-35000Ksh (250-300US\$), isn't that ridiculous!!!



WE NEED THE GOVERNMENT, BIG PHAMACEUTICALS, OTHER ENTITIES TO GET INVOLVED

HOW? By implementing health policies that covers the cost for rare/growth disorders since growth plays a vital role in a child's development, failure of growth leads to stunted growth.

Reduce taxes imposed on medicine intended to improve the health and quality of life for patients.

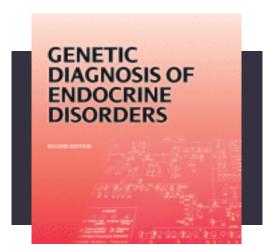
PHARMACEUTICALS

Create a systematic channel that patients can access medicine at ease.

Ensure that there is consistency of production of medicine which is affordable and safe for patients.

LATE DIAGNOSIS

With late diagnosis, most of these conditions go untreated and are irreversible, early diagnosis is always the key. We are looking for Organizations to support our cause and our doctors, we have a few endocrine specialized doctors in Africa, in Kenya alone we have less than 20 paediatric endocrine doctors, there is need for more training programs for healthcare workers

We are excited to announce that we will be working with CLAN child health Africa, MATES4Kids and CAH international to raise awareness about Congenital Adrenal Hyperplasia (CAH), we will share the latest developments on ways of improving the healthcare systems nation wide, we also hope to implement the practise of New Born Screening (NBS) in Kenya, a practice which is lacking in most African countries. NBS tests can help detect rare disorders that can cause series health problems in children if it's not early detected.

We will have a platform just for CAH patients, where every voice matters.
